Finishing : Semi-Aniline

Technical Description:

Campbell is a semi aniline leather with a natural grain. It is slightly buffed but still maintains its natural grain therefore differences in grain are completely normal. It has a shiny look and a rich hand. The article has a mottling (savage) effect which is obtained by particular machine cilinder. Its thickness is from 1.4 to 1.6 mm. Being a natural grain with mottling effect color variations in tone are normal.
