Technical Description:

Madison is a pure aniline leather with natural grain and it is 1,6 – 1,8 mm thick. The hide used for this leather originates from South America. The accurate tanning process used for this leather results that each hide has an exceptional soft hand and reflects the benefits of natural leathers. Scars, wrinkles, differences in tone and grain, insect bites are proof of its natural state and beauty. Exposure to direct sunlight, powerful lamps or humidity should be avoided.
